Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for the City of Port Jervis District of Public Works (DPW) Garage project in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Port Jervis, located at 20 Hammond St., Port Jervis, NY 12771. The site of the project is located at 1 Franklin St., Port Jervis, NY 12771. The funding would be used to replace the existing City of Port Jervis DPW garage. The current undersized, uninsulated, and corrugated wood building contains deteriorating portions constructed in the late 1800's and 1950's. The garage will be used to repair and store city vehicles and equipment, including temperature-sensitive equipment, fire engines, and large vehicles that do not fit in the existing garage. This project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because the expansion in the building's length and height will allow for expanded work options on city equipment, reducing the need to outsource repairs and providing cost savings to the City and its taxpayers.

The project has a federal nexus because it is for the purposes authorized in Section 306 of the Consolidated Farm and Rural Development Act, 7 U.S. Code section 1926(a).
